Nominations for Trustees of Transition Chichester

The following people have indicated their willingness to stand for election as Trustees.

Jan Sander: Jan has a career history in engineering and management, but also studied environmental subjects including geology and ecology with the Open University. He has been an active volunteer for a range of historical and environmental charities over the past 16 years, the majority of which are in the Chichester area. Jan has been involved with Transition Chichester for over 4 years and currently holds the role of treasurer.

Anita van Rossum: Previously the owner of a childcare facility and a boutique in Valencia, Spain Anita has been interested in environmental issues her entire life, she was the driving force behind introducing recycling facilities to previously less green areas of Spain. Anita utilises her skills in networking and liaison within Transition Chichester as well as through forging links with external organisations. She is also events co-ordinator and ensures vital funds are brought into the organisation through community fundraising events. She also heads up the successful monthly Eco Cinema.

John Wilton: John is a retired architect who has lived in Chichester since 1973. He worked in both public and private sectors, and for the last 15 years before retiring was working as a project manager and advisor for the NHS locally.
